








To many sawy knife users, the Endura 4 is the perfect everyday carry cutting tool. Enhancing it with a Wharncliffe-style blade redefines that perfection and supercharging it with K390 MICROCLEAN® blade steel raises the bar even further. Specially developed to provide the extreme wear resistance and strength needed in the most demanding industrial applications, K390 is a state-of-the-art tool steel. The full-flat-ground Wharncliffe blade of this knife takes full advantage of these properties to deliver exceptional cutting performance, edge retention, and toughness. Whether you need scalpel-like precision or sheer cutting power, its perfectly straight edge is up to the task. All other features of this knife are consistent with the time-tested Endura 4 Lightweight, including a high-strength back lock mechanism, skeletonized stainless steel liners, a four-position pocket clip, and a lightweight fiberglass-reinforced-nylon (FRN) handle molded in the signature blue color of Spyderco's elite K390 family.







The original Wharncliffe blade pattern was created by an English nobleman who believed that its perfectly straight cutting edge and acute point would significantly enhance the functionality of the pocketknives of the day. Spyderco's Lit' Native Wharncliffe revitalizes that logic by empowering our compact, ultra-convenient Lit' Native with a full-flat-ground Wharncliffestyle blade. The spine of the satin-finished CPM S30V stainless steel blade curves gracefully downward to meet the straight cutting edge at an exceptionally keen point. Its edge and point tuck into an ergonomic handle featuring nested stainless steel liners, peel-ply-textured G-10 scales, a high-strength Compression Lock® mechanism, and a deep-pocket wire clip that is reversible for left or right-side tip-up carry. "Get it straight" when it comes to pocketknife performance. Get a Lit' Native Wharncliffe.

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Spyderco co-founder Sal Glesser designed the lightweight, mid-sized RockJumper™ to fit the needs of outdoor enthusiasts and climbers. Based on the success of that popular model and feedback from its devoted users, Sal went back to the drawing board and created the LeafJumper. The LeafJumper features the same ergonomic handle design as its cousin, including its skeletonized stainless steel liners, fiberglass-reinforced-nylon (FRN) scales, non-slip Bi-Directional Texturing™, four-position pocket clip, stout back lock mechanism, and positive self-close function. Its VG-10 stainless steel blade also has a minimal ricasso (the unbeveled, full-thickness area nearest the handle) to offer the maximum edge length. What sets the LeafJumper apart, however, is its leaf-shaped blade. Full-flat ground, satin finished, and available in PlainEdge and SpyderEdge™ formats, it features a slightly upswept edge profile that raises and reinforces its point, increasing its versatility for many applications.



The original Lil' Temperance was designed by Spyderco co-founder Sal Glesser as a compact yet heavy-duty folding knife suitable for defensive use. Over the years, Sal has refined the design several times, emphasizing its utilitarian function without compromising its hell-for-stout spirit. The latest evolution of this venerable design transcends previous versions by replacing their traditional G-10 handle scales with injection-molded fiberglass-reinforced nylon (FRN). In addition to its light weight, FRN adds the extreme grip security of a deeply molded Bi-Directional Texture pattern. Stainless steel liners nested in the scales form the foundation of the knife's high-strength Compression Lock mechanism and anchor its broad-based, four-position pocket clip. The stout blade of the Lil' Temperance 3 is full-flat ground from VG-10 stainless steel and has a minimal ricasso to maximize its edge length. Available in a choice of PlainEdge or fully serrated SpyderEdge formats, the Lil' Temperance 3 Lightweight is a force to be reckoned with.






Edge Configurations















The smallest member of Spyderco's popular Value Folder series, the Ambitious is an ultra-compact cutting tool that cuts with big-knife authority. In its lightweight configuration, it trades the G-10 scales of the original for injection-molded fiberglass-reinforced nylon (FRN) with a high-traction Bi-Directional Texture pattern. Taking that evolution one step further, the Ambitious Lightweight Black Blade cloaks the knife's full-flat-ground 8Cr13MoV stainless steel blade in a non-reflective black oxide coating. Consistent with that theme, the handle's full skeletonized stainless steel liners, four-position pocket clip, and other hardware also sport stealthy black coatings. Available in a choice of either PlainEdge or fully serrated SpyderEdge, both configurations feature a sturdy LinerLock mechanism to lock the blade securely open during use.



Following in the footsteps of its bigger brothers the Tenacious™, Resilience™, and Persistence™, this elite expression of the Ambitious Lightweight supercharges its performance with Crucible® CPM S35VN blade steel. The finely tuned chemistry of this American-made particle metallurgy steel promotes the formation of niobium carbides along with vanadium and chromium carbides, enhancing its toughness without sacrificing wear resistance. The full-flat-ground blade of this knife takes full advantage of these properties and is available in a choice of PlainEdge or fully serrated SpyderEdge formats. The satin-finished blade is housed in a handle featuring bright blue fiberglass-reinforced-nylon (FRN) scales, non-slip Bi-Directional Texturing, skeletonized full stainless steel liners, a stout LinerLock mechanism, and a versatile four-position pocket clip that provides a choice of left or right-side, tip-up or tip-down carry.



This limited-edition Sprint Run celebrates the Siren design by rendering it with solid carbon fiber handle scales and a blade crafted from Crucible CPM S90V particle metallurgy stainless steel. The full-flat-ground, satin-finished, PlainEdge blade is supported by a stout back lock mechanism and proudly features a fully accessible Trademark Round Hole for swift, positive opening with either hand. The handle also features a reversible deep-pocket wire clip that balances secure, ambidextrous, tip-up carry with quick access.



This limited-edition Sprint Run expression of the Manix 2 showcases a blade crafted from CPM 15V. Boasting almost a 15 percent vanadium content, this remarkable material offers the highest wear resistance of any cold work tool steel available today. The full-flat-ground, satin-finished blade of this knife is further enhanced by a specialized heat-treating protocol developed by acclaimed custom knifemaker Shawn Houston. The result is a blade that offers extreme sharpness and unparalleled edge retention. To further distinguish this one-of-a-kind Sprint Run, it features brown G-10 scales with a non-slip peel-ply texture. All other aspects of this elite knife are consistent with the time-tested Manix 2 platform, including full skeletonized stainless steel liners, a stout Ball Bearing Lock™ mechanism, and a reversible pocket clip that provides a choice of left or right-side tip-up carry.







Elevating the SpyOpera design to all-new heights of sophistication, this Sprint Run proudly features a blade crafted from Thor™ pattern martensitic Damascus steel. Created by the Swedish firm Damasteel®, this extraordinary material is produced by a proprietary powder metallurgy process that forge welds layers of RWL 34 and PMC 27 into a state-of-the-art stainless Damascus steel. After the blade is precision machined and full-flat ground to final form, it is acid etched to reveal its intricate layered pattern. Equally distinctive, this knife's handle showcases solid carbon fiber scales painstakingly finished to offer smooth, ergonomic, crowned surfaces. All other features of this exquisitely crafted knife are consistent with the proven SpyOpera design, including thoughtfully crowned surfaces on the spine of the blade and lock bar.
