Inspired by custom knifemaker David Rydbom's "Bill the Butcher" design, the Stovepipe blends dramatic style with serious performance. Its stout cleaver-shaped blade is crafted from 4mm (.157-inch) thick CPM® 20CV stainless steel and has a deep hollow grind for superior edge geometry. The handle is constructed from two slabs of solid titanium joined by a titanium backspacer. Both scales are painstakingly machined to create beautifully crowned outer surfaces and the reverse-side scale forms the foundation of the knife's Reeve Integral Lock (R.I.L.) mechanism. The oversized pivot pin is machined with artistic accents and serves double duty as an overtravel stop for the lock bar. To allow convenient carry, the Stovepipe includes a machined titanium clip configured for right-side, tip-up carry. The clip, scales, backspacer, and blade all feature a no-nonsense, industrial-style stonewashed finish.



Designed by noted personal-defense expert Michael Janich, the YoJumbo is an "upsized" version of his time-tested Yojimbo™ 2. In this elite Sprint Run expression of it, the knife's stunning, satin-finished Wharncliffe blade is supercharged with CPM S90V—a vanadiumrich powder metallurgy stainless steel that offers an exceptional combination of edge holding and corrosion resistance. Its handle is also enhanced with handsome peel-ply-textured solid carbon fiber scales. All other features, including its nested stainless steel liners, high-strength Compression Lock®, and four-position pocket clip are consistent with the standard version of this model.



This limited-edition Sprint Run™ expression of the Urban elevates this non-locking SLIPIT™ design to all-new levels of sophistication. Its blade is meticulously crafted from Damasteel® Björkmans Twist™ DS93X™—a spectacular pattern-welded steel with a grain reminiscent of natural wood. Named after a Swedish bladesmith who wanted a more intense expression of Damasteel's Dense Twist™ pattern, this remarkable blade material is produced by Damasteel's proprietary powder metallurgy process, which ensures an exceptionally homogenous structure for superior cutting performance. No two pieces of this steel are identical—a fact that is clearly revealed by the full-flat grind of this knife's blade. To showcase this stunning blade steel, the handle of this elite knife features smooth ivory G-10 scales that house its notched-joint non-locking mechanism, a stainless steel backspacer, and a reversible deep-pocket wire clip that provides left or right-side tip-up carry. A truly breathtaking expression of one of Spyderco's cult-classic folders, this Urban Sprint Run is sure to be a coveted collector's item.



The Stretch 2 XL Lightweight is the newest member of a proud lineage of cutting tools that has spanned more than three decades. The earliest knives in this family were optimized for hunters and outdoor enthusiasts, but later evolved to become true all-purpose tools. Inspired by its progenitor, the Stretch 2, the XL version extends the design's overall length by eight percent, while packing 13 percent more blade length into its straight-spined, full-flat-ground VG-10 stainless steel blade. Despite its larger size, its linerless fiberglass-reinforced-nylon (FRN) handle actually reduces its weight by 29 percent compared to the Stretch 2, which has stainless steel liners. Its injection-molded handle features Bi-Directional Texturing for a positive grip, a fully configurable four-position pocket clip, and a sturdy back lock mechanism. Offering XL-sized performance in a package weighing a scant 2.7 ounces (77 grams), this knife sets a new standard in lightweight, everyday carry cutting tools.



Designed by a British aristocrat in the early 19th century, the Wharncliffe is both a scalpel and a powerhouse cutting tool in a single blade. Now the versatility of this unique blade shape is available in the perfect mid-sized folder in the form of the Endela<sup>®</sup> Lightweight Wharncliffe. To optimize its edge geometry, the blade is full-flat ground from VG-10 stainless steel and is available in both PlainEdge™ and SpyderEdge™ versions. It is paired with a fiberglass-reinforced-nylon (FRN) handle featuring non-slip Bi-Directional Texturing™, skeletonized stainless steel liners, a high-strength back lock, and a fully configurable four-position pocket clip.





The original Persistence is a proud member of Spyderco's Value Series of folders and ounce-for-ounce one of the best buys on the knife market. The new Persistence Lightweight takes this pocket-friendly design to the next level by swapping the original G-10 scales for injection-molded fiberglass-reinforced nylon (FRN). FRN scales reduce the knife's weight by almost 10 percent and add the enhanced non-slip grip of a Bi-Directional Texture pattern. All other features are faithfully consistent with the original, including an 8Cr13MoV blade, full stainless steel liners, a LinerLock mechanism, and a fourposition pocket clip. It is also available with a choice of PlainEdge or CombinationEdge™.



For tactical end users concerned with light discipline and those who simply prefer the no-nonsense look of a black blade, this version of the Persistence Lightweight cloaks the 8Cr13MoV blade in a stealthy black oxide coating. Consistent with that theme, the knife's Bi-Directional Textured FRN scales are also black and the handle's hardware, full stainless steel liners, and four-position pocket clip also sport nonreflective black coatings. The full-flat-ground blade of this knife is available with a choice of a PlainEdge or CombinationEdge.





steel blade features a classic Wharncliffe pattern. Available with a choice of a plain or fully serrated edge, this straight-edged profile cuts with both exceptional power and precise control. All other features of this knife are identical to the original Harrier 2 Lightweight, including skeletonized stainless steel liners, textured fiberglass-reinforced-nylon (FRN) scales, a sturdy back lock, and a fully configurable four-position pocket clip.

The latest version of this popular design maximizes its cutting performance and versatility with the addition of a straight-edged Wharncliffe-style blade. Preferred by many sawy knife users, the Wharncliffe blade shape offers an exceptional balance of control and sheer cutting power—especially when rendered with a low-friction full-flat grind. The 8Cr13MoV stainless steel blade of this knife is available with a choice of edge configurations and is paired with a lightweight FRN handle that houses skeletonized stainless steel liners, a user-friendly back lock, and a four-position clip that supports left or right-side, tip-up or tip-down carry.



The Robin 2 Lightweight is a budget-priced alternative to the Spyderco Dragonfly™ 2. Its highly refined design has always been respected for cutting with authority far beyond its compact size, but the Wharncliffe-style blade of this Robin 2 Lightweight takes that respect to all-new heights, offering unparalleled cutting performance and control, while faithfully maintaining all the proven features of the original design. Crafted from 8Cr13MoV stainless steel, the Wharncliffe blade is available in both plain and fully serrated edge configurations.

### MURRAY CARTER® Minarai™ Series

Designed by world-renowned knifemaker Murray Carter, official heir to a 420-year-old Japanese bladesmithing lineage, Spyderco's Murray Carter Collection faithfully translates Carter's coveted handcrafted designs into affordable factory-made kitchen cutlery. The newest additions to this proud family of knives are his Minarai Series. Literally meaning "to look and learn," *minarai* is a quintessentially Japanese way of describing the role of an apprentice. In that spirit, the Minarai Series expresses five of Carter's highly refined designs in an economical format featuring solid CTS® BD1N stainless steel blades and injection-molded polypropylene handles. A remarkable fusion of time-tested traditional designs and state-of-the-art modern materials, the Minarai Series proudly includes the following patterns:

**K15PBK Petty**—From the French petit meaning "small," this knife is the equivalent of a Western paring knife and is ideal for peeling and slicing fruits and vegetables, making garnishes, and other detailed food-preparation tasks.

**K16PBK Funayuki**—Literally translated as "ship going," this versatile pattern was extremely popular with fishermen. It excels at chopping, draw-cutting, and other general kitchen tasks.

**K17PBK Nakiri**— Meaning "vegetable cutter," this knife's unique rectangular shape and slightly upturned edge make it the perfect tool for precisely pushcutting all kinds of vegetables. The Nakiri's blade shape also allows its length to remain consistent after years of sharpening.

K18PBK Bunka Bocho—An all-purpose knife suitable for preparing meat, vegetables, and fish, the Bunka Bocho literally means "cultural knife," because of its role in making traditional Japanese cuisine in the home.

Closely related to the Santoku ("three virtues") knife, the Bunka Bocho has a more acute and utilitarian point.

**K19PBK Gyuto**—Literally "cow blade," the Gyuto is the Japanese equivalent of the Western chef's knife. Its versatile design is suitable for slicing, carving, chopping, and detailed food preparation chores.

Spyderco's unique Mule Team Series elevates the concept of a "mule" in-house test knife by allowing our customers to join in the process. Offered without handles or sheaths, our Mule Team blades are also popular "kit" blades for aspiring knifemakers and hobbyists. Our 32nd Mule Team installment features laminated san mai (three-layer) construction using a central core of SRS13 clad between layers of SUS405. SRS13 is a unique powder metallurgy martensitic stainless steel enriched with molybdenum, vanadium, and tungsten that is the steel of choice for many premiumgrade Japanese kitchen knives. SUS405 is a ferritic stainless steel that provides greater overall blade strength and toughness while allowing the hard SRS13 core to excel at cutting performance.

#### Mule Team CPM MagnaCut

The latest and most anticipated addition to Spyderco's Mule Team family features CPM® MagnaCut, a remarkable powder metallurgy steel conceived by Larrin Thomas, a Ph.D. in Metallurgical and Materials Engineering. Developed specifically for the cutlery industry, MagnaCut challenges traditional stainless steel chemistry by reducing the amount of chromium in the steel to a precise range while adding vanadium and niobium. The vanadium and niobium effectively combine with the steel's carbon content to form hard carbides, while leaving the chromium in solution to fend off corrosion. The result is a blade material that offers an extraordinary balance of wear resistance, toughness, and corrosion resistance. Please note, the MT35P was revealed digitally in December 2021 and is completely sold out. It is listed here for reference only.
